Prerequisites to Paramedic Program:

Ohio EMT Certification

Successful completion of EMS 1002 (Paramedic Prep) *or* have college-level Anatomy & Physiology on a transcript **(Transcript grade must be a "C" or greater)**

Minimum score of 75% on the Fisdap Exam (The Fisdap Exam can be taken in EMS 1002 course or may be scheduled by contacting (614) 287-2812 if you have passed a college-level Anatomy & Physiology course)

Paramedic Program Admission

Step 1

Candidates must complete and submit a Paramedic Program application to ems@cscc.edu by the submission deadline. (Failure to submit all required Health Record forms will result in a block of registration into program courses.)

Step 2

Candidates are to complete Paramedic Health Record forms and submitted them to the Health Records Office in Union Hall.

Step 3

Candidates will need to complete a background check and drug screen prior to program start date.

Step 4

Candidates are required to attend the Paramedic Program orientation to provide crucial program information.
