

## Other General Requirements for the Degree

Students must complete up to the intermediate level II of a foreign language. Options for completing this requirement may be discussed with a Kent State academic advisor. Options for completing requirement are available through Columbus State and/or Kent State University and may be available online.

#### Notes about the degree at Kent State University

• To graduate from Kent State, students must have completed a minimum of 120 credit hours. Forty-two (42) of those credits must be in the Upper Division (3000 level and above. Thirty (30) hours must be earned at Kent State of which 9 are upper division courses in the student's major.
