As you read the questions, think about any other critical information that could be a factor when determining if the career would be a good match for you.

Sample Questions

- What kind of training or background is necessary for this type of work?
- Our How did you get this job, and what kinds of experiences & preparation helped you the most?
- What are the future career opportunities in this field?
- What advice would you give to someone trying to break into this field?
- ♦ Is there a demand for people in this occupation?
- What are the specific skills needed to do this job?
- Describe the duties and responsibilities of your position?
- What future industry trends do you project could effect your occupation?
- What specialized technology does the organization use?
- Which professional journals and organizations would help me learn more about this field?
- ♦ What is your least favorite part of your work? What does your average day look like?
- ♦ What types of training do companies offer persons entering this field?
- What personal qualities or abilities are important to being successful in this job?
- ♦ What are the challenges in balancing work and personal life?
- ♦ Are there entry level jobs that might prepare me for this career field?
- Can you recommend another person in the field I may also interview? Could I reference your name when I call him/her?
